Notification of amendment to the Boston Conservatives Branch Lottery rules

For your information it has been agreed that the following amendment to the Lottery Rules has been incorporated into the Rules of the Boston Conservatives Branch Lottery scheme with effect from September 2022:

Prizes

'10.12 If no winning combination of numbers is drawn for 4 consecutive weeks, then for the following draw, if there is again no winning combination of 6 numbers, a combination of 5 numbers will be taken, and then 4 numbers if a combination of 5 numbers do not produce a winner.'

This amendment is designed to ensure that the prize fund does not continue to roll over without end and should ensure that one or more winners will be drawn, in what will become a 'must be won' month.

The first such draw took place in Sept 2022 and resulted in two winners after there being no previous winners.
